## In the run-up to Red Nose Day you could use the quiz and puzzles:


- · in circle time sessions
- · as the basis for fun, engaging virtual sessions if pupils are working from home
- · as a fundraiser, asking for donations or a small fee to take part.

# There are four separate activities to choose from:

- **Red Nose Day Quiz** with three rounds focusing on the colour red, noses and riddles. Why not put on a big quiz event? See the box below for ideas...
- **Spot the difference** can your pupils spot the six changes to the picture?
- Word search find the Red Nose Day related words
- **Fundraising maze** follow the lines to match the child with the fundraising activity.

If you want to use the activities to raise some cash, ask the pupils to make a donation or pay a small fee to take part. And don't forget to use the giro in your fundraising pack or a downloadable paying-in slip to pay in any money you raise.




