Tapestry is an online Learning Journey which helps teachers and parents to record, track and celebrate children's progress in early years education.



Wrap Around Care

- We aim to support parents by providing out of school childcare from 7.45 am until 6.00 pm;
- It currently operates for all children attending Fairfield School and is complementary for all Kindergarten children
- We provide nutritious meals and age appropriate play activities within our dedicated state of the art facility.





- Our Wrap Around Care Facility for Kindergarten is held in the Kindergarten Dining Hall and then the Kindergarten classrooms;
- Places should be booked half termly in advance to ensure we can arrange appropriate staff schedules;
- We will accept late bookings in cases of emergency, subject to availability.



Transition

- Teachers arrange visits and activities to other areas within school, such as the Cookery room and the library.
- Participation in whole school events.
- Kindergarten children will have team sessions or videos with the Reception team if we cannot visit.
- The children will be familiar with many of the Subject Specialists.
