

Last Wednesday Fairfield Y2 had a visit from a rather special violinist. Folk fiddler and LGS old lad Sam Sweeney took time out from his critically acclaimed and very moving 'Made in the Great War' tour to play to the Y2's.

Sam, who just a few days ago was playing to an audience of 10 000 for the BBC's annual 'Prom in the Park' concert performs with Bellowhead and has won several BBC Radio 2 folk musician awards. Power of Forces- Glossary

Glossary

Attract – to pull something so that it comes nearer.

Compress – to squash smaller.

Elastic band – a loop of material that can stretch and then go back to its usual size.

Force – a push or pull.

Friction – a force between surfaces in contact.

Magnet – a metal object that can make pieces of iron or steel stick to it.

Magnetic – able to be attracted by a magnet.

Non-magnetic – unable to be attracted by a magnet.

Pole – either of the two ends of a magnet.

Repel – to push something away.

Spring – a piece of metal wound into a spiral or bent so that it bounces back into shape after it is compressed or stretched.

Stretch – to pull something so that it becomes longer.
